**Under this agreement for 2022
Bajool State School will receive**

\$20 698.00

This funding will be used to

- Ensure that 100% of students in years Prep to 2 are working towards achieving national minimum standards in literacy and numeracy
- Develop a learning plan for the students who are at risk for achieving below national learning standards
- Increase the number of students in Prep to Year 2 results in English to high or very high from 40% to 50% (6 students to 8 students)
- Increase the number of students in Prep to Year 2 results in Mathematics to high or very high from 45% to 55% (7 students to 9 students)
- Provide in-service for newly appointed Teacher Aides to work with students who require targeted intensive support.

Our initiatives include

- Provide professional development for newly employed Teacher Aides in explicit instruction using the school-based literacy and numeracy program – “First Steps Number/Measurement”, “Seven Steps Writing”, “Sight Words”, “Bajool SS Spelling Program”, “Phonemic Awareness”
- Continue to diagnose students’ current reading ability as per school assessment schedule and pre and post-test students’ reading comprehension as per the school wide reading program
- Develop individual learning plans that include individual goals and expectations for each child below NMS in reading, writing and numeracy.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Assigning an extra Teacher to the P-2 classroom (1/2 day per week) allowing students to receive targeted literacy and numeracy instruction (supplemented from Targeted Intervention funding)	\$10 000
Assigning an extra Teacher Aide to the P-2 classroom allowing specialist support for high needs students to receive targeted literacy and numeracy instruction (supplemented from Targeted Intervention funding)	\$10 000
Professional development for Teacher Aide (Teaching Principal released to conduct PD)	\$ 698
